IABA And Asian Law Caucus Awarded \$50,000 Toward Fellowship to Combat Discrimination Against Iranian Americans

January 11, 2011 - Washington, D.C. The Iranian American Bar Association in joint cooperation with the Asian Law Caucus were recently awarded a grant of \$50,000 from the PARSA Community Foundation, the leading philanthropic organization severing the Iranian-American community.

The grant helps fund a joint fellowship program offered by IABA and ALC to combat discrimination of Iranian-Americans in the United States.

The Fellow will be housed at the Korematsu Institute and work collaboratively with the National Security & Civil Rights Program of the Asian Law Caucus. The fellow will be responsible for addressing the racism and stereotyping borne by "post 9/11 impacted communities" through policy, communication, public education, and law.
